Dear Mr. Danner:

On July 26, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission assessed a \$2,300 penalty against Pullman Disposal Service, Inc., (Pullman Disposal) for violations of WAC 480-70-236(1) related to improper billing.

On August 3, Pullman Disposal filed an Application for Mitigation of Penalties. Although the company requested a hearing, it failed to provide a basis for its request. On August 16, the commission denied the company's request for a hearing, but afforded the company the opportunity to submit a written explanation supporting its request to mitigate the penalty. On August 20, Pullman Disposal submitted its written explanation.

Staff respectfully requests that the commission schedule a hearing to facilitate settlement discussions that may address mitigation of the penalty. Thank you for your consideration.
