Hi John,

Bill asked that I respond to your inquiry on behalf of the staff here at the Washington State Utilities and Transportation Commission (Washington UTC).

My records show that the following information was submitted for the San Juan exchange:

After further research we agree with your assessment that the MAP ATTRIBUTE FILE (# 2. above) for the San Juan exchange "SA Code" should be updated as 522408 (not 522422).

The reason for this is that CenturyTel of Washington, Inc. (SAC 522408) and CenturyTel of Inter Island, Inc. *have combined study areas for purposes of reporting*, even though they remain as separate legal entities. Therefore, CenturyTel of Washington, Inc.'s OCN is 2408 and CenturyTel of Inter Island, Inc.'s OCN remains as 2422.

We were unsure if the FCC wanted to match the company name with the SAC or with the OCN given the combined nature of the SACs.
