Evergreen Park Dr. SW, in Olympia. RCW 81.68.015 provides auto transportation companies' the opportunity to petition the Commission requesting forbearance from rate regulation. SeaTac Shuttle, LLC, (SeaTac) is holder of certificate C-1077 issued by the Commission under RCW 81.68 to provide both scheduled and door-to-door auto transportation service between Whidbey Island and Sea-Tac International Airport. SeaTac also holds charter and excursion authority under certificate CH-456 issued by the commission in accordance with RCW 81.70. SeaTac requests forbearance from rate regulation pursuant to RCW 81.68.015. SeaTac asserts this service is for recreational purposes only and should be allowed forbearance from rate regulation (RCW 81.68.051).

SeaTac proposes to provide auto transportation service between Whidbey Island and:

1. King County Convention Center, CenturyLink Stadium or Safeco Field for sporting shows and events, boat shows and events, home shows and events, RV shows and events, and golf shows and events; and
2. Sporting events, concerts, casinos, wineries, and performing arts theaters in Washington.
