9	Today is Monday, October 6, 2014, at 1:30 a.m., and
10	we're here for a prehearing conference to discuss scheduling and
11	other procedural issues.

- 22 would be not be a filing of exhibits with the Commission, but
- 23 merely an exchange among the parties, and that date would be one
- 24 week prior to the hearing or January 6th.
- JUDGE PEARSON: Okay. Thank you.

Is there anything else that we need to address while we're here? MR. FASSIO: I don't believe so, Your Honor. JUDGE PEARSON: Okay. MR. FASSIO: Unless there's something from the Company. MS. WICKS: No. JUDGE PEARSON: Okay. I will issue an order reflecting what was discussed here today, and we are adjourned. Thank you. MR. FASSIO: Thank you. (Proceeding concluded at 1:37 p.m.) -000-
