Hi Steven,

Following my phone calls with you and Suzanne today, I would like to address some of the resulted confusions pertinent to our application Docket # TG-152373. In response to the UTC's letter dated on March 23, 2016 and per Penny's instruction on how to file for a waiver for exemptions from the commission rules, EcoMed Services submitted our revised application on April 11, 2016 and before the due date of April 15, 2016. For your review, attached is UPS delivery confirmation of our application.

Based on my previous communication with Penny, UTC's staff will be reviewing our request and make a recommendation to the commission on whether to allow or deny the request during a commission's open meeting process. Also, EcoMed Services was supposed to be notified of the open meeting date so that we, along with MHS, can address the commission during the meeting assigned to discuss the petition. Accordingly, it is safe to conclude that UTC's Letter dated today didn't account for our response. Also, our submission of April 11 included completed tariff and map of territories that was still mentioned as missing requirements in today's notification letter. We have also addressed all remaining requirements of USDOT, income statement, and revenue as part of a conditional permit as we are continue to develop and finalize the scope of the project with our Multicare Health System customer. Due to the large scope of the project, MHS has to allocate a team to work with EcoMed Services to compile and address any remaining requirements. As a result, the submitted letter of Intent was a revised support statement that we had to resubmit to complete our application. Please note that our efforts since our first submission were to work with the commission to complete all requirements taking into considerations our distinct solutions while abiding by our customers' Non-Disclosure Agreement.
