Staff's Request to Impose Suspended Penalties

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On April 26, 2017, the commission issued Order 02 in this docket, classifying Tiraogo Simporre as a common carrier of household goods within the state of Washington, ordering the company not to operate as a household goods carrier without a permit, and assessessing a penalty of \$5,000. Order 02 also suspended \$4,500 of the penalty on the condition the company not operate without a permit, and pay the remaining \$500 as agreed upon in the payment schedule in Appendix A. The payment schedule required the company to make two payments of \$250 each, due April 28 and May 31, 2017.

As of today, Tiraogo Simporre has failed to make any payments toward the penalty owed. Staff requests the commission impose the suspended portion of the penalty, with the total penalty amount of \$5,000 immediately due and payable.
