RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment No. TV-170518

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on June 30, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Creech and Son LLC in the amount of \$1,000 for violations of WAC 480-15-480, which requires household goods carrier companies to file their annual report and pay regulatory fees by May 1 each year. Creech and Son LLC did not file a complete 2016 annual report or pay its 2017 regulatory fee by May 15, 2017, and incurred a penalty of \$1,000. The Commission suspended a portion of the penalty on condition that the annual report was filed, and the regulatory fee and the \$250 portion of the penalty were paid within 15 days of receipt of the Notice. To date, Creech and Son LLC has not met the conditions of the Notice. By Notice dated August 24, 2017, the Commission imposed the full penalty, and indicated that the balance of \$1,000 was due. The Commission has not received the \$1,000 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$1,000 balance.
