## TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 21, 2018, 2018, the Commission issued an order instituting a special proceeding on its own motion to determine whether Deavondia Taylor d/b/a I Heart Movers, LLC (Deavondia Taylor), has engaged, and is engaging, in business as a household goods carrier within the state of Washington without the authority required by RCW 81.80 (classification proceeding).

The Commission ordered that Deavondia Taylor appear before the Commission in this classification proceeding on April 11, 2018, at the Commission's headquarters in Olympia, Washington, to give testimony and evidence under oath as to its operations.

On March 21, 2018, Deavondia Taylor contacted Commission Staff and requested a continuance on the basis that he will be out of the country on April 11, 2018. Deavondia Taylor and Commission Staff agreed to reschedule the classification proceeding for May 18, 2018.
