Today is Wednesday, August 21st, 8 2019, and the time is 9:08 a.m. My name is Laura 9 Chartoff, I'm an administrative law judge with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission. 10 This is Docket TG-190490, Paulino Jose Gonzalez 11 12 and Veronica Luna, doing business as Universal Moving. So, before we went on the record, I was advised 13 by Staff that Mr. Gonzalez was unable to appear, that 14 Veronica Luna is here, but she has difficulty 15 understanding English and needs a translator. 16 17 Does Staff have a recommendation on this? MS. MCPHERSON: In discussion with Mr. Gonzalez, 18 19 he had stated that he had planned -- and I just spoke with Ms. Luna, and she concurred that they plan to 20 contest the violations. 21 22 Considering the necessity of a translator and the intended request to contest the violations, I would 23 recommend that it be postponed, and prepare for a 24 25 translator and hearing at the next date.

- 1 JUDGE CHARTOFF: Okay. And I agree that it
- 2 makes sense to postpone this because I'm not comfortable
- 3 moving forward without a translator.
- 4 I'm wondering, does Ms. Luna -- would she be
- 5 willing to -- can you -- is Ms. Luna present?
- 6 Can you come forward. I just want to ask you...
- 7 Oh, that. So if you understand, I just want to
- 8 pick a hearing date, and I'll either -- I have some dates
- 9 available. Do --
- MS. LUNA: Can I say something?
- JUDGE CHARTOFF: Mm-hmm.
- MS. LUNA: My husband is about 15 minutes away
- 13 from here. He said he is almost get here. Is that okay
- 14 if we can wait or -- because he was trying to do it by
- 15 himself. His English is not perfect, but he was trying
- 16 to do it. I don't know if there is a possibility to wait
- 17 another ten minutes maybe today.
- 18 JUDGE CHARTOFF: So you believe he is on his
- 19 way --
- MS. LUNA: Yeah.
- 21 JUDGE CHARTOFF: -- and he will be here in about
- 22 ten minutes.
- MS. LUNA: Mm-hmm.
- 24 JUDGE CHARTOFF: Is it your understanding that
- 25 he wants to contest the violations?

- 1 MS. LUNA: Yeah, because he is the one that do
- 2 the job. He is using -- my name is in the business
- 3 license, just because I have some of the things, but I
- 4 don't really know what he is doing because I am not
- 5 participating doing the labor. So he is the one that can
- 6 tell what he was really doing. And he also advertise his
- 7 business.
- 8 JUDGE CHARTOFF: Okay. Is Staff okay with
- 9 recess for ten minutes to see if he appears?
- 10 MS. MCPHERSON: Ten minutes. I mean, I'm fine
- 11 to recess at any time, barring the schedule of the
- 12 hearing room, and I think we are clear for the day.
- But I thought you -- did you say 50 minutes?
- MS. LUNA: In about ten, 15 minutes.
- MS. MCPHERSON: Ten, 15 minutes. Okay. I
- 16 misunderstood.
- 17 I am fine with that. I do have hesitation,
- 18 considering the nature of what's going to be discussed,
- 19 that if we also need an interpreter anyway to postpone.
- JUDGE CHARTOFF: Yeah, okay.
- 21 Since Mr. Gonzalez is planning on contesting the
- 22 violations anyway, what we do in that case is we set
- 23 another hearing where we actually get into the substance
- 24 of the matter, whether you're -- you know, the company is
- 25 operating as a solid waste collection company. So I'm

- 1 going to go ahead and set another hearing to discuss
- 2 that. I don't know if he needs to be present for that.
- 3 We can go ahead and just select a date where we're going
- 4 to continue this proceeding, and at that time, we will
- 5 have an interpreter and we can go ahead and you can
- 6 present your case --
- 7 MS. LUNA: Okay.
- JUDGE CHARTOFF: -- as to why the company is not
- 9 subject to regulation of the Commission.
- 10 So I have a couple of dates picked out. It
- 11 doesn't look like you have a datebook in front of you.
- 12 I'm looking at October 1st -- basically, sometime in the
- 13 first week of October.
- 14 Do you know -- judging from the look on your
- 15 face, I'm guessing you don't know your's and
- 16 Mr. Gonzalez's availability?
- 17 MS. LUNA: Yeah, we still don't know, but we
- 18 have plenty of time to get permission from work. Because
- 19 I did it, but my husband couldn't make it today.
- 20 And all the dates that you have, is that in the
- 21 morning or --
- 22 JUDGE CHARTOFF: I could do the morning or the
- 23 afternoon.
- MS. LUNA: Because we prefer afternoon.
- JUDGE CHARTOFF: Okay. So I'm going to suggest,

- 1 is there -- would any day of the week be better than any
- 2 other? Other, Monday --
- MS. LUNA: I think we can do it any day, just if
- 4 it is in the afternoon, it will be better.
- 5 JUDGE CHARTOFF: Okay. So I'm looking at my
- 6 calendar and fast-forwarding to October.
- 7 So I can do Monday -- oh, I should ask Staff
- 8 too. I'm looking at Monday, October 7th, at 1:30?
- 9 MS. MCPHERSON: My calendar is clear. I have a
- 10 clear calendar for that day.
- JUDGE CHARTOFF: Okay. Thank you.
- 12 So I am going to schedule the hearing for
- 13 Monday, October 7th, at 1:30. I will send you a notice.
- 14 When you get the notice, if that hearing date does not
- 15 work for you and Mr. Gonzalez, please let us know as soon
- 16 as possible within a few days of receiving the notice,
- 17 and we can reschedule to another date. Suggest another
- 18 date within a week or two and it should -- we would be
- 19 able to approve that.
- 20 Do we have -- Ms. McPherson, do we have an
- 21 address for the company?
- MS. MCPHERSON: Yes. The address is current.
- JUDGE CHARTOFF: Okay.
- 24 MS. MCPHERSON: For the record, they are still
- 25 at 820 Fir Street Northeast, Olympia, in Thurston County.

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               JUDGE CHARTOFF: Thank you.
               Is there anything else we need to discuss today?
               MS. MCPHERSON: No, Your Honor.
