## TO ALL PARTIES:

On August 26, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Consolidating Dockets; Approving Safety Management Plan, Upgrading Safety Rating; Imposing and Suspending Penalties (Order 01) in Dockets TV-200635 and TV-200636. Order 01 assessed a \$4,050 penalty against Washington Movers LLC (Washington Movers or Company), a \$2,500 portion of which was suspended subject to the conditions that (1) the Company not incur any repeat violations of critical regulations upon re-inspection, and (2) the Company timely pay the \$1,550 portion of the penalty that was not suspended.

On August 26, 2022, Staff filed a letter informing the Commission that Washington Movers had timely paid the unsuspended portion of the penalty and had not incurred any repeat violations of critical regulations. In its letter, Staff states that it believes the Company has complied with all the conditions of Order 01.

The Commission finds that Washington Movers has complied with the conditions of Order 01. The \$2,500 portion of the penalty that was suspended is now waived, and these dockets are closed.
