RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against Zayo in the Amount of \$1,000, Docket DG-200749

TO ALL PARTIES:

On October 5, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$1,000 penalty (Penalty Assessment) against Zayo (Company) for one violation of Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 19.122. In the Penalty Assessment, the Commission offered the Company the option to suspend, and ultimately waive, an \$800 portion of the penalty subject to the conditions that (1) Zayo pay the \$200 portion of the penalty that was not suspended within 15 days of receiving the Penalty Assessment and (2) the Company commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 within 12 months from the date of the Penalty Assessment.

On October 14, 2020, the Company paid the \$200 portion of the penalty that was not suspended and notified the Commission that it accepted the remaining condition.

On November 4, 2021, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that the Company had not incurred any additional violations of the dig law since the Penalty Assessment. In its letter, Staff recommends the Commission waive the \$800 suspended penalty and close the docket.

The Commission agrees that Zayo has complied with the conditions of the penalty suspension. The \$800 suspended penalty is thus waived, and this docket is closed.
