Consistent with requirements outlined in WAC 408-109-120(3)(c) and WAC 480-07-140(5) Puget Sound Energy ("PSE") provides an electronic version of its second quarter 2020 Exhibit 3: Program Details updates and revisions. This nineteenth version replaces version eighteen. The update represents program enhancements, measure revisions, and adaptive management demonstrated by PSE program staff to effectively respond to circumstances created by the Covid-19 pandemic and PSE's updated electric target, approved by the Commission in Order 02 of Docket UE-190905.

Highlights of key revisions include, but aren't limited to:

- As part of its continuous improvement efforts, PSE updated text and table formatting throughout the document for consistency.
- PSE added "Covid-19 Alert" boxes at key program discussion areas. These alerts inform customers and Stakeholder of PSE's ongoing efforts to protect their safety, and the safety of PSE contractors and employees.
- Several programs are running limited-time offers on measure to enhance the availability to customer who have potentially been impacted by the pandemic. Offers include, but are not limited to increased rebate amounts, lowered energyuse thresholds, and lower baseline thresholds.
- New measures, formerly not cost-effective prior to PSE developing its revised electric savings target, have been added in selected programs.
