Tariff No. 11: Tip Fee revision with Commission and Customer Notifications

*** Present provisions are:**
45 day notice to customers for all tariff changes per RCW 81.28.050

*** Proposed changes are:**
Notify customers on the first bill as stated in WAC 480-70-271 (2)(a). This would occur October 1st, 2024.

*** Explain why the company is proposing this tariff revision:**
The Company discovered that the tip fee put into the Tariff and approved in TG-240390 overstated the amount as it included the refuse tax. The Company is seeking to correct the Tariff rate and revise all rates impacted by the tip fee rate. Customers will be notified and the Company has reached out to Consumer Protection.

*** Explain why the Commission should allow this tariff revision to take effect with less than 30 days' notice (45 days' notice for solid waste):**
The historic practice is to notify customers of a tip fee increase on the first bill per WAC 480-70-271(2)(a) this allows us to keep rate payer costs down by avoiding unnecessary additional printing and postage. Additionally the Company is seeking to reduce the current Tip Fee in the current Tariff to the correct amount.
