In the amount of \$3,900	GRANTING PAYMENT ARRANGEMENT

BACKGROUND

- 1 On November 25, 2025, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment against Gus & Jack Moving Company LLC d/b/a Sno-King Moving Co. (Gus & Jack or Company) in the amount of \$3,900 for violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15-550, Cargo Insurance; WAC 480-15-555, Criminal Background Checks for Prospective Employees, and WAC 480-15-560, Vehicle and Driver Safety Requirements, which adopts Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations (49 C.F.R.) Part 391 – Qualification of Drivers, 49 C.F.R. Part 393 – Parts and Accessories for Safe Operation, and 49 C.F.R. Part 395 – Hours of Service of Drivers.
- 2 On December 30, 2025, Gus & Jack filed with the Commission an application for mitigation of the \$3,900 penalty.
- 3 On January 13, 2026, the Commission entered Order 01, which reduced the penalty to \$2,950 and suspended a \$1,450 portion of the penalty for a period of two years, to be waved, subject to conditions. Order 01 required the Company to pay the \$1,500 portion of the penalty that was not suspended within 10 days or enter a mutually agreeable payment arrangement with Commission staff (Staff).
- 4 On January 20, 2026, Staff filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that Staff and the Company have come to a mutual agreement on a proposed payment plan, as follows:

Installment	Due Date	Amount
1	February 2, 2026	\$500
2	March 2, 2026	\$500
3	April 1, 2026	\$500

- 5 Staff also proposes—and Gus & Jack Moving is aware—that if the Company fails to pay any installment by the due date, the entire balance, including the suspended penalty, will become due and payable immediately without further Commission order.

DISCUSSION

- 6 The installment payment schedule Staff and the Company propose is reasonable. Accordingly, the Commission approves the proposal with one modification. The Company may make additional payments in advance of the payment due dates or pay an increased amount on the due dates, but no additional payment or increased amount will relieve the Company of its obligation to make its timely monthly installment until the full amount of \$1,500 is satisfied.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 7 (1) The \$1,500 portion of the penalty is not suspended in this docket and is due and payable by Gus & Jack Moving Company LLC d/b/a Sno-King Moving Co. to the Commission in installments as set out in paragraph 4, above.
- 8 (2) If Gus & Jack Moving Company LLC d/b/a Sno-King Moving Co. fails to pay any installment by 5 p.m. on the date it is due, the unpaid balances, including any suspended penalties, will immediately become due and payable without further order by the Commission.
- 9 The Secretary has been delegated authority to enter this order on behalf of the Commissioners under WAC 480-07-904(1)(h).
