The proposal would reorganize and revise chapter 480-04 WAC to make the rules governing public access to Commission information and documents easier for members of the public to use and understand.

The proposal would repeal and replace chapter 480-09 WAC, the Commission's procedural rules, with a new chapter 480-07 WAC that is better organized, easier to understand, and easier to use. New chapter 480-07 WAC also eliminates some rules, and includes revisions to existing rules and new rules that reflect practices the Commission and those who do business with the Commission recognize as improving and streamlining procedures for formal proceedings and informal interaction between the Commission and members of the public.

Both chapters are revised consistent with the requirements of Executive Order No. 97-02 regarding regulatory improvement.
