Re: Miscellaneous – Climate Commitment Act

Please provide an estimate of the revenue to PSE associated with the consignment of no-cost allowances to auction in calendar years 2023, 2024, and 2025.

Response:

Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) is unable to provide an estimate of anticipated revenue from the consignment of no-cost allowances because the Department of Ecology has not yet established a price floor, price ceiling or other associated allowance mechanisms in rule. Further, allowance price and associated revenue will be greatly informed by the supply and demand of the cap-and-invest trading market which cannot be determined at this time.
