Dear Mr. King,

In Order 11, Docket UT-061625, the Commission approved the AFOR Implementation Plan filed by Qwest, Commission Staff, and Public Counsel. The Implementation Plan includes deadlines for the processes established by Order 06 in the same proceeding. Specific to this filing, the Implementation Plan requires CenturyLink QC to file certain reports on September 1 of each year of the AFOR. The required reports attached to this filing are as follows:

- Market Share Report - “The market share data should consist of updates to Qwest’s exhibit (Teitzel, Exhibit No. 12C) that show access line counts by wire center for business, residential, and public access lines.” – Order 06, ¶ 116
- Pricing Change Report – “The pricing information should include data for changes in prices, terms, and conditions for all service that are detariffed by the AFOR as well as changes to residential package prices.” – Order 06, ¶ 116
- Broadband Availability Report – “The report should update Qwest’s Supplemental Response to Bench Request 3 “with 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010 data for each state it serves and with data covering wire centers for Washington.” – Order 06, ¶ 42

The following two reports required by the Implementation Plan are not included in this filing because CenturyLink QC completed its \$4 million DSL expansion commitment and issued final reports on this commitment in its 2011 Annual AFOR Report filing:

- Broadband Expansion Expenditures Report – “The report should describe how the \$4 million DSL expansion commitment has been spent until fully disbursed.” – Order 06, ¶ 40
- Washington Rural Broadband Rural Expansion Report – “The report should describe how the \$4 million DSL expansion commitment has been spent until fully disbursed.” – Order 06, ¶ 40

Pursuant to WAC 480-07-160(3), CenturyLink QC requests that those reports so designated be held confidential, as these documents contain valuable commercial information, the release of which would be detrimental to the company. Redacted versions of the confidential documents are included with this filing.
