### **MEMORANDUM**

- NATURE OF PROCEEDING: Docket UT-063061 involves Qwest Corporation's (Qwest) request for arbitration of an interconnection agreement with Eschelon Telecom, inc., (Eschelon) pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §252(b) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
- 2 PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND: The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) convened a prehearing conference in this docket at Olympia, Washington, on September 15, 2006, before Administrative Law Judge Patricia Clark. In Order 02 Prehearing Conference Order, the Commission established a procedural schedule. The procedural schedule was modified, at the request of the parties, by Order 04.
- 3 **MOTION:** On October 11, 2006, the parties filed a joint request to vacate the procedural schedule, adopt a revised procedural schedule, and schedule a prehearing conference to establish additional procedural deadlines, as necessary.

- 4 COMMISSION DECISION: The joint motion to vacate the current procedural schedule is granted. Both parties concur that the schedule should be vacated so no party will be adversely affected by this action. Moreover, the parties waived the nine-month deadline for the Commission to issue an Arbitrator's Report and Order, so this action will not adversely affect the Commission's ability to render a decision in a timely manner. The procedural schedule proposed by the parties is reasonable and should be adopted. The revised procedural schedule is attached to this Order as Appendix A.
- 5 PREHEARING CONFERENCE: The joint request to schedule a prehearing conference to establish additional procedural deadlines is granted. A prehearing conference is scheduled to convene on November 6, 2006, beginning at 1:30 p.m., in Room 206, Chandler Plaza Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.
