Public Counsel is filing this "status report" regarding the individual customer notice in this case pursuant to paragraph 8 of the Prehearing Conference Order (Order No. 02) entered April 29, 2008. Because discussions are not yet complete, we request that an additional report-back date be set for Friday, June 27, 2008. At that time, Public Counsel will file a follow-up status report regarding the content and format of the notice.

Northwest Natural Gas Company, Public Counsel, and Commission Consumer Affairs (the parties) are working together to draft a notice that complies with the requirements of WAC 480-90-194 and -197. The parties began discussions on the notice shortly after the April 24, 2008 Prehearing Conference and are currently exchanging drafts.
