## NOTICE CANCELING EVIDENTIARY HEARING (Set for June 22, 2022, at 9:30 a.m.)

Re: Tree Top, Inc. v. Cascade Natural Gas Corporation, Docket UG-210745

TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 24, 2021, Tree Top, Inc., (Tree Top) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a formal complaint (Complaint) against Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade). The Complaint alleges that Cascade imposed an exorbitant overrun entitlement penalty on Tree Top that it asserts is not fair, just, or reasonable.

The Commission convened a second virtual prehearing conference on February 22, 2022, and on March 8, the Commission entered Order 04, Second Prehearing Conference Order (Order 04), adopting an agreed procedural schedule and setting an evidentiary hearing in this matter for June 22, 2022, at 9:30 a.m.

On April 8, Tree Top filed with the Commission direct testimony in this proceeding.

On May 12, 2022, Cascade filed with the Commission response testimony in this proceeding.

On May 26, 2022, Tree Top filed with the Commission reply testimony in this proceeding.

On June 8, 2022, the parties contacted Administrative Law Judge Andrew J. O'Connell, indicating that neither party intended to ask cross-examination questions during the evidentiary hearing. Further, the parties request that the hearing be canceled and that this matter be decided on a paper record. The parties do not request any modification to the procedural schedule's deadlines for filing legal briefs.

## THE COMMISSION CANCELS the evidentiary hearing in this proceeding set for June 22, 2022, at 9:30 a.m. and determines that this matter will be decided on a paper record.
