**NOTICE REQUESTING RESPONSE TO SUPPLEMENTAL COMMENTS
(May 2, 2002)**

RE: Tel West Communications, LLC, Petitioner, v. Qwest Corporation, Respondent.
Docket No. UT-013097

TO THE PARTIES:

The Fifth Supplemental Order served on April 11, 2002, denied Qwest Corporation's motion to suspend proceedings. However, Qwest was allowed the opportunity to submit additional arguments and evidence within 10 days of this Order to establish that the Commission intends to make a determination whether IMA GUI provides access to Qwest's OSS in substantially the same manner as SONAR or IMA EDI in the SGAT/271 Proceeding. Qwest filed additional arguments and evidence on April 22, 2002.

The Fifth Supplemental Order also stated that the Commission would consider Qwest's submission subject to WAC 480-09-810. After examining the submission the presiding officer believes that a possible change in a significant term of the order may be appropriate. Tel West is requested to file a response to Qwest's submission no later than May 2, 2002. Tel West has previously requested that additional time be allowed for a response; however, the granting of additional time would compromise the procedural schedule that has been agreed to by the parties.

Tel West may comply with this notice by fax filing and serving documents, provided that paper copies are filed and served on the next business day. Parties should include in cover letters accompanying fax filed documents a statement that the Secretary or presiding officer has authorized fax filing. Parties must continue to provide the Commission with an electronic version of filed documents on diskette along with paper copies. Parties are requested to also provide an electronic version via email attachment to all other parties and the presiding officer as a courtesy at the time documents are filed or served.
