**NOTICE GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME
(New Deadline March 8, 2007)**

RE: *AT&T Communications of the Pacific Northwest, Inc., TCG Seattle, and TCG Oregon; and Time Warner Telecom of Washington, LLC, v. Qwest Corporation*, Docket UT-051682

TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 7, 2007, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) received a request for extension of time from AT&T Communications (AT&T). AT&T requested a one-day extension of the March 7, 2007 deadline for filing a response to Qwest's Motion for Stay of Proceeding. AT&T asserted that the extension was necessary due to unforeseen scheduling constraints of persons involved in preparing the response.

According to WAC 480-07-385(2), the Commission will grant a continuance if the requesting party demonstrates good cause for the continuance and the continuance will not prejudice any party or the Commission. AT&T stated good cause for the continuance.

The parties are granted a one-day extension of the paper-filing requirement, allowing parties to submit documents to the Commission electronically on the filing deadline. Parties may submit documents electronically either through the Commission's Records Center Web Portal (www.wutc.wa.gov/e-filing) or via e-mail to records@wutc.wa.gov, and must file an original, plus five (5) paper copies, of the document with the Commission by the following business day. Finally, to perfect filing, parties must provide courtesy copies to the presiding administrative law judge and advisory staff as well as the parties to the proceeding.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the request for extension of time filed by AT&T Communications is granted. The new deadline for filing a response to Qwest's Motion for Stay of Proceeding is March 8, 2007.
