BACKGROUND

- 1 On September 26, 2002 the Commission entered its Thirty-Eighth Supplemental Order, Final Order on Reconsideration, Part B, in this proceeding, resolving issues on petitions for reconsideration. The Order directed Verizon to submit compliance filings no later than eight business days after service of the order.
