SECOND ERRATA CORRECTING ORDER 06

RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Avista Corporation d/b/a Avista Utilities, Dockets UE-150204 and UG-150205 (consolidated)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On February 19, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 06, Order Denying Joint Motion for Clarification, Denying Petition for Reconsideration, and Denying Motion To Reopen the Record in the abovereferenced matters. On February 29, 2016, the Commission issued an Errata Correcting Order 06. Specifically, the Commission made the following correction to paragraph 23, Order 06:

Avista states that it does not challenge the end result of the Commission's order decreasing the Company's electric revenue requirement by \$8.1 million, and argues that the decrease is within the "bounds of reasonableness" when compared to the Company's recommendation of a decrease an increase in electric revenues of \$5.7 million and other parties' recommendations for much larger decreases.

We note that this modification was an error, and the first sentence of paragraph 23 is corrected to read:

Avista states that it does not challenge the end result of the Commission's order decreasing the Company's electric revenue requirement by \$8.1 million, and argues that the decrease is within the "bounds of reasonableness" when compared to the Company's recommendation of <u>a-decrease</u> an increase in electric revenues of \$5.7 million and other parties' recommendations for much larger decreases.
