Dear Judge Rendahl:

On March 12, 2007, CMS filed an intervention in Docket No. UG-070332, which concerns certain tariff revisions proposed by Cascade Natural Gas Corporation. About that time, the Commission had posted on its website a copy of a draft order that would have accepted those revisions without suspension. Out of concern that the tariff revisions would not be suspended, CMS' intervention petition raised several issues of which we thought the Commission should be aware as it considered whether to suspend Cascade's tariff revisions. Those issues were raised in the form of a motion, conjoined with the intervention petition. Ultimately, the Commission issued a suspension order without addressing any of these issues.

The CMS motion for clarification of Commission Order No. 3, filed yesterday in Docket No. UG-061256, addresses several of the issues raised in the earlier intervention pleading. Lest there be any confusion, CMS is not asking the Commission to address these issues twice. I would ask the Commission to address the issues in a single order, to be issued after CMS, Cascade and the other parties file their responsive pleadings on April 6, 2007.
