- 1 This is an application for authority to provide commercial ferry service on the navigable waters of Lake Washington, adjacent to Seattle. The Commission convened a hearing on the application at Seattle, Washington, on June 12 through June 15, 2001, before Administrative Law Judges Dennis J. Moss and William E. Hendricks.
- 2 On September 19, 2001, Administrative Law Judge Moss entered an Initial Order. The initial order was served on all parties of record.
- No petition for administrative review was filed within the 20 days allowed by rule for filing. In accordance with RCW 34.05.464 and WAC 480-09-780(6), the Commission accepts the findings of fact and conclusions of law, and adopts the Initial Order, as its own for purposes of this proceeding.
- 4 The result of this order, and of companion orders entered today to two other commercial ferry companies,¹ is an enhanced opportunity for the provision of comprehensive but diverse commercial ferry services on Lake Washington.

ORDER

- 5 THE COMMISSION ORDERS That the Initial Order is affirmed and adopted for purposes of this proceeding. In so doing,
- 6 The Commission grants authority to Seattle Ferry Service to provide commercial ferry service on Lake Washington between South Lake Union and Port Quendall.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That that the Commission will revise and reissue certificate of public convenience and necessity No. BC-123 to Seattle Ferry Service to read as as set out in Appendix A to this order.
