#### BACKGROUND

- On August 8, 2001, Genie Service Company, Inc., C-1033, (Genie) filed with the Commission a new Tariff No. 3, naming increased rates and canceling and replacing Tariff No. 2. The increases ranged from 28.5 percent to 75.0 percent.
- 2 On August 29, 2001, the Commission entered a Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff No. 3 pending an investigation to determine whether the new rates were fair, just and reasonable.
- Genie and Staff worked together, gathering the required information to make a determination as to the merits of the proposal, including separation of regulated operations from unregulated. Some of that information is actual data; some has been estimated.
- 4 As a result of that additional work, Genie has now filed revisions to proposed Tariff No. 3 which increases rates by 20 percent, which is less than the amounts originally requested.

#### FINDINGS

(1) Genie is an auto transportation company and is a public service company subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.

(2) Genie and Staff have now presented actual and estimated data that allows a determination as to the merits of the rate proposals contained in Revised Tariff No. 3.

- (3) The revisions which generate 20 percent of additional revenue are fair, just, and reasonable.
- 7 (4) It is consistent with the public interest to dismiss the Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions in this docket and to allow the revisions to Genie's Tariff No. 3, effective on October 25, 2001, generating an additional 20 percent of revenue on an annual basis.

### O R D E R

#### 8 THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 9 (1) The Commission dismisses the Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions in this docket, dated August 29, 2001.
- 10 (2) Tariff No. 3 revisions generating 20 percent of additional revenue filed in this docket on October 18, 2001, shall be effective on October 25, 2001.
- 11 (3) Genie shall implement new accounting procedures ensuring that in the future a ready separation of regulated from non-regulated operations will be available.
