Re: Staff Investigative Report

Dear Ms. Washburn:

I received your letter of February 13, 2007, informing me that Staff had completed its investigation of AT&T Communications of the Pacific Northwest Inc.'s ("AT&T's") alleged improper billing for collect calls from certain correctional facilities in Washington State. I write to let you know that AT&T has accepted Staff's invitation to discuss the matter and we will be meeting on the mutually agreeable date of March 15, 2007.

In your letter you cite RCW 80.04.405 as "potentially" applicable. As the Commission has not found AT&T liable, nor afforded AT&T any due process rights in association with Staff's allegations, AT&T does not believe that RCW 80.04.405 is presently applicable. If you have a different view regarding the application of this statute at this time, please let me know as soon as possible. Otherwise we look forward to discussing this matter with Staff on March 15<sup>th</sup> and I encourage you to contact me should you have any other questions or concerns regarding AT&T.
