Recommendation

Discussion

On January 23, 2008, Gold Beach Water Company, Inc. (company), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) tariff revisions that would generate \$11,100 (15.7 percent) in additional revenue per year. The company serves about 185 customers on central Vashon Island in King County. The company's last rate increase became effective in July 2006. This filing is a monthly surcharge of \$5.00 to cover capital costs associated with a new storage tank and booster pumping station. The surcharge would remain in effect for 20 years or until recovery of \$192,607, whichever occurs first.

The company notified its customers of this rate increase by mail on February 1, 2008. The commission has received no customer comments on this filing as of February 19, 2008.

Commission staff has completed its review of the company's supporting financial documents, books and records.
