Recommendation

Take no action on this filing at this time to allow for customer comments.

Discussion

On June 16, 2008, Sanitary Disposal, Inc., (Sanitary or company), filed with the Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) tariff revisions that would generate approximately \$15,600 (7.14 percent) in additional revenue per year. The tariff revisions propose to increase rates for solid waste collection. The proposed rate revisions are prompted by increases in all operating costs. Sanitary serves approximately 214 residential and commercial regulated customers in southern Benton County. Sanitary's last general rate increase became effective in July 1994.

Today's presentation allows customers or other interested parties to comment to the commission. No action is required by the commission. Staff will make its recommendation to the commission at the open meeting on July 31, 2008.

Sanitary notified its customers of the proposed rate increase by mail on June 30, 2008. The commission has not received any comments on this filing to date.
