1. The Commission finds good cause to support the request and authorize the proposed changes to become effective with Less Than Statutory Notice on: October 1, 2008.
2. The proposed changes will expire on: February 28, 2009
3. The temporary 1.41% fuel surcharge in all rates and charges is the result of increased fuel costs incurred by the company during the months of June, July and August 2008, to be collected from customers as follows:

For customers who are billed monthly for services in arrears, the fuel surcharge applies to all services provided in the months of October, November and December 2008.

Customers who are billed quarterly for services – one month in arrears, the current month and one month in advance:

December 2008 ✓	November & December 2008 and January 2009
January 2009 ✓	December 2008 and January & February 2009
