Docket TV-091929; Application for Permanent Authority

On December 21, 2009, Pedro Miranda Iturbide, d/b/a Warrior's Moving, filed Docket TV-091929 requesting permanent household goods authority.

The commission granted the company temporary authority subject to conditions pending a decision on its application for permanent authority. The company has operated under Household Goods Carrier Permit No. THG-63841, since February 25, 2010.

Under WAC 480-15-330, the commission will grant or deny an application for permanent authority after conducting a complete review of the application filings, supporting statements, reports, or other information necessary to determine fitness, public interest, and current or future public convenience and necessity.

Compliance staff worked with the company providing technical assistance during its temporary operations. Investigator Tom McVaugh completed a Safety Compliance Review, a Household Goods Technical Assistance and Records Review Checklist. Investigator McVaugh found the company in general compliance and on November 30, 2010, he recommended the applicant be considered for permanent authority.

The current provisional permit THG-63841 is in order as follows:

- o Records Center does not have an annual report on file since the permit wasn't issued until 2/25/10.
- o Financial Services reports the company has nothing on file.
- The commission does not have any outstanding penalty or other fine against THG-63841.
- Consumer Affairs does not have a pending consumer complaint.
- Transportation Safety does not have a pending compliance action.

I recommend the commission grant TV-091929 without hearing and reissue permit no. THG-63841 to HG-63841, Pedro Miranda Iturbide, d/b/a Warrior's Moving, as unrestricted permanent authority to operate as a household goods carrier in the state of Washington.
