DECLARATION OF VIRGIL SANTOS

VIRGIL SANTOS, under penalty of perjury under the laws of the state of Washington, declares as follows:

- 1. I am over 18 years of age, a citizen of the United States, a resident of the state of Washington, and competent to be a witness.
- 2. I am employed by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) as an Administrative Assistant in the Telecommunications Section, Regulatory Division. I have been employed at the Commission for 11 years and 11 months. As an Administrative Assistant, my responsibilities include the maintenance of addresses of all the telecommunications companies registered to Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission.
- 3. On July 13, 2010, I received an e-mail from the Commission's Records Center Staff stating that the penalty assessment sent by first class and certified mail addressed to Telenational Communications, Inc., 450 Old Peach Tree Road, Suite 101A, Suwane, GA 30024, was returned by the U.S. Postal Service.
- 4. On July 16, 2010, I called the point of contact, Kenyatta Perkins, at 678-894-4112. The telephone number was no longer in service.
- 5. On August 4, 2010, I checked the website address of Telenational Communications, Inc., doing business as T.N.C. Communications, and found their corporate address which is:

6. I immediately called 402-392-1110 and spoke with Nancy Moorefield. Ms. Moorefield told me that Kenyatta Perkins was no longer with Telenational Communications, Inc., and that the new point of contact is Mike Prachar, the Operations Manager.
