

**SUBJECT:** Docket TV-101646; Application for Permanent Authority

On October 1, 2010, Jonathon F. Sheridan, d/b/a JFS Transport, filed Docket TV-101646 requesting permanent household goods authority.

The commission granted the company temporary authority subject to conditions pending a decision on its application for permanent authority. The company has operated under Household Goods Carrier Permit THG-64232, since March 30, 2011.


Under WAC 480-15-330, the commission will grant or deny an application for permanent authority after conducting a complete review of the application filings, supporting statements, reports, or other information necessary to determine fitness, public interest, and current or future public convenience and necessity.

Compliance staff worked with the company providing technical assistance during its temporary operations. Investigator John Foster completed a Safety Compliance Review, a Household Goods Technical Assistance and Records Review Checklist. Investigator Foster found the company in general compliance and on October 3, 2011, he recommended the applicant be considered for permanent authority.

The current provisional permit THG-64232 is in order as follows:

- Records Center does not have an annual report on file since the company wasn't issued authority until 3/30/11.
- Financial Services reports nothing for the company.
- The commission does not have any outstanding penalty or other fine against THG-64232.
- Consumer Affairs does not have a pending consumer complaint.
- Transportation Safety does not have a pending compliance action.
- Company rep attended HHG training on October 12, 2011

I recommend the commission grant TV-101646 without hearing and reissue permit. THG-64232 to HG-64232 to Jonathon F. Sheridan, d/b/a JFS Transport, as unrestricted permanent authority to operate as a household goods carrier in the state of Washington.
