- On February 14, 2011, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment in Docket UW-110213 against Lowper, Inc. (Lowper) in the amount of \$10,500, alleging multiple violations of WAC 480-110, which governs the regulation of water companies. Specifically, the penalty assessment alleged violations of WAC 480-110-433(3), Charging rates subject to regulation.
- On February 23, 2011, Lowper filed with the Commission a request for hearing stating that it has not received a list of the violations. Lowper also states that on February 24, 2010, it informed the Commission that the Clallam County Public Utility District would be taking over the Lowper Water System.
- On March 3, 2011, the Commission's regulatory staff (Staff) filed a Response stating that it disagrees with Lowper's contention that the violations did not occur, and does not oppose Lowper's request for hearing. Further, Staff requests that the hearing be scheduled on April 27, 2011, coincident with the hearing in Docket UW-091006.¹
- The Commission will hear this matter under the Administrative Procedure Act (APA), particularly Part IV of RCW 34.05 relating to adjudications. The provisions of the APA that relate to this proceeding include, but are not limited to RCW 34.05.413, RCW 34.05.422, RCW 34.05.431, RCW 34.05.440, RCW 34.05.449, and RCW

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34.05.452. Statutes involved, in addition to those previously cited, include those within RCW 80.01, RCW 80.04 and RCW 80.28, including but not limited to RCW 80.01.040, RCW 80.04.020, and WAC 480-110-433. The Commission will follow its procedural rules in WAC 480-07 in this proceeding.

- The ultimate issues include whether the penalty should be mitigated and what actions are necessary for Lowper to maintain future compliance, pursuant to statutory provisions of RCW 80.04.
- THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a hearing in this matter at 1:30 p.m., on Wednesday, April 27, 2011, in Room 206, Second Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington. The hearing is set at the same time as the hearing in Docket UW-091006.
