- 1 On March 8, 2012, Jay the Mover, LLC (Jay the Mover or Applicant) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to operate as a household goods carrier in the state of Washington under RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-15. The application was signed by Jason Thomas Smith, the company’s owner. On March 14, 2012, the Commission issued Order 01 granting Jay the Mover temporary authority subject to conditions.

- 2 Commission Staff reviewed and investigated Jay the Mover’s application as well as Consumer Complaint No. 114468 and associated statements made by Mr. Smith to both the complainant and to Staff. As a result of its review, Staff recommended that the Commission immediately suspend Jay the Mover’s temporary authority and then deny the application.

- 3 On July 19, 2012, the Commission issued an Order Suspending Temporary Authority and a Notice of Intent to Deny Jay the Mover’s application for permanent authority (Order 02), which is attached and incorporated by reference in this order. Paragraphs 11-19 of Order 02 set forth Staff’s factual allegations supporting the suspension and the proposed denial of the application. Order 02 also provided Jay the Mover with an opportunity to request a hearing by August 2, 2012, to contest those factual allegations. Order 02 ¶¶ 27-28. Jay the Mover did not request a hearing by that date or otherwise respond to Order 02.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 4 The application filed by Jay the Mover, LLC, on March 8, 2012, in Docket TV-120329 for a permit to operate as a household goods carrier in the state of Washington is denied.
- 5 The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-905(1)(k).
