RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment No. UW-120861

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on July 13, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Cristalina L.L.C. in the amount of \$2,100 for 21 violations of WAC 480-110-505, which requires water companies to file an annual report with the Commission by May 1 each year. The Commission sent Cristalina L.L.C. a Second Notice on August 15, 2012, and a Final Notice on September 19, 2012. On August 16, 2012, the Company filed an application for mitigation of the penalty. On October 4, 2012, the Commission issued Order 01: Order Denying Mitigation, leaving the \$2,100 balance due and owing within 15 days.

The Commission has not received the \$2,100 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$2,100 balance.
