4 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

5 A. My name is Katherine J. Barnard. My business address is 10885 NE Fourth  
6 Street, Bellevue, Washington, 98004-5591.

7 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

8 A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) as Director of Revenue  
9 Requirements and Regulatory Compliance.

10 **Q. What are your duties as Director of Revenue Requirements and Regulatory**  
11 **Compliance for PSE?**

12 A. As Director of Revenue Requirements and Regulatory Compliance, I am  
13 responsible for strategy, policy, direction and coordination of PSE's interests on  
14 state regulatory issues. I oversee state regulatory processes and compliance  
15 requirements, including, audits, rate cases and regulatory proceedings. I represent  
16 PSE in regulatory issues with state regulators and other constituents. I negotiate  
17 rate and tariff issues with customers, agencies, stakeholders and regulators. I am  
18 responsible for testifying as a company witness in state rate cases and other  
19 regulatory proceedings.

20 **Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.**

21 A. I graduated from the University of Washington with Bachelor of Arts degrees in

1 both Business Administration and Arts & Sciences. The Bachelor of Arts degree  
2 in Business Administration was in Finance with additional course work in  
3 accounting.

4 From 1985 to 1987, I was employed by Ernst & Whinney's Telecommunications  
5 Consulting Group, in which role I was responsible for the preparation of cost  
6 allocation studies for several small telephone companies.

7 From 1988 to 1990, I was the Manager – Separations at Nevada Bell where my  
8 responsibilities were the development of rates for Nevada Bell's Federal  
9 Communications Commission tariff filings along with Federal Communications  
10 Commission and National Exchange Carriers Association compliance reporting.

11 From 1990 to 1992, I was employed by the Washington Utilities and  
12 Transportation Commission as Revenue Requirement Specialist. My  
13 responsibilities included reviewing tariff filings, affiliated interest applications,  
14 and performing audits of several telephone companies' compliance reports.

15 From 1992 to 2011, I was employed by Cascade Natural Gas Corporation.

16 Between 1992 and 1996, I served as a Senior Accountant, in which role I was  
17 responsible for developing the jurisdictional balances used in regulatory reporting.

18 From 1996 to 2011, I worked in the Regulatory Affairs department of Cascade  
19 Natural Gas Company and served as Manager of Regulatory Affairs prior to my  
20 departure in June 2011.

21 In July 2011 I joined PSE in my current role as Director of Revenue  
22 Requirements and Regulatory Compliance.
