TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 21, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment (Penalty Assessment) against Estate Fence, LLC (Estate Fence or Company) in the Amount of \$1,000 for violations of RCW 19.122. In the Penalty Assessment, the Commission provided the Company the opportunity to suspend the entirety of the penalty subject to the following conditions: (1) Estate Fence owner and field supervisors completed NUCA Dig Safe Training within 12 months of the Penalty Assessment, and (2) Estate Fence commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 within 12 months of the Penalty Assessment. If the Company complied with both conditions, the Commission would waive the suspended penalty.

On April 5, 2019, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that Estate Fence had met both of the conditions. In its letter, Staff recommended the \$1,000 suspended penalty be waived.

The Commission agrees that Estate Fence has complied with the conditions of the penalty suspension. The \$1,000 suspended penalty is now waived, and this docket is closed.
