RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against Bacon Concrete, Inc., in the Amount of \$3,500, Docket DG-180247

TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 23, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment (Penalty Assessment) against Bacon Concrete, Inc., (Bacon Concrete or Company) in the Amount of \$3,500 for two violations of RCW 19.122. In the Penalty Assessment, the Commission provided the Company the opportunity to suspend \$2,500 of the penalty subject to the following conditions: (1) Bacon Concrete Pay the \$1,000 portion of the penalty that was not suspended within 15 days of receiving the Penalty Assessment, (2) Bacon Concrete employees involved in excavation, including management, completed NUCA Dig Safe Training within 12 months of the Penalty Assessment, and (3) Bacon Concrete commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 within 12 months of the Penalty Assessment. If the Company complied with all three conditions, the Commission would waive the suspended portion of the penalty.

On April 17, 2019, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that Bacon Concrete had met all of the conditions. In its letter, Staff recommended the \$2,500 suspended portion of the penalty be waived.

The Commission agrees that Bacon Concrete has complied with the conditions of the penalty suspension. The \$2,500 suspended portion of the penalty is now waived, and this docket is closed.
