RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against Luxury1 Limo, LLC, in the Amount of \$1,400, Docket TE-180596

TO ALL PARTIES:

On July 25, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a penalty of \$1,400 against Luxury1 Limo, LLC (Luxury1 Limo or Company) in this docket for 16 violations of Washington Administrative Code 480-30-221, Vehicle and Driver Safety Requirements.

On August 29, 2018, the Company requested mitigation, and on September 21, the Commission issued Order 01, Denying Mitigation; Suspending Penalty, in Part (Order 01). Order 01 suspended \$700 of the penalty for two years subject to the conditions that: (1) Luxury1 Limo does not incur any repeat violations of acute or critical regulations; (2) the Company pay the \$700 portion of the penalty that was not suspended or file jointly with Staff a proposed payment arrangement within 10 days of the effective date of Order 01; and, (3) the Company submit a "15-day letter" to Commission staff (Staff) within 10 days of the effective date of Order 01 containing a detailed plan for correcting and avoiding future violations.

On November 2, 2018, Staff filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that Luxury1 Limo had failed to pay the remaining penalty or submit its 15-day letter. Staff recommends that the suspended portion of the penalty be imposed.

Due to Luxuryl Limo's failure to comply with the terms of Order 01, the full \$1,400 penalty is now due and payable.
