Dear Mr. Johnson:

On February 15, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Order Granting Petition Subject to Condition (Order 01) in the above-referenced docket. Order 01, among other things, required Avista Corporation d/b/a Avista Utilities (Avista or Company) to file an updated work plan for its Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) by February 28, 2019.<sup>1</sup>

On February 27, 2019, Avista filed with the Commission its updated 2020 Integrated Resource Planning Work Plan (work plan). The Company's work plan provides the timeline for completion of IRP tasks and proposed agenda items for Technical Advisory Committee meetings.

Commission Staff (Staff) reviewed the compliance filing provided by Avista dated February 27, 2019, and finds that it contains sufficient detail with respect to updates to the work plan. Therefore, Staff believes that the filing complies with the Commission's Order 01, entered February 15, 2019.
