COMMISSION In accordance with WAC 480-109-300, Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power), a division of PacifiCorp, submits its 2018 energy and emissions intensity metrics report. Consistent with last year's report, Pacific Power is also enclosing a summary of short-term sales and purchases by counterparty. While this summary provides additional transparency and granularity, due to the unique nature of how the company's net power costs are calculated in Washington, amounts provided in the counterparty summary will not tie to actual net power costs.

The short-term sales and purchases summary is confidential and being provided to the Commission in accordance with WAC 480-07-160. The confidential document includes valuable commercial information, specifically confidential cost and financial information. Disclosure of such information would harm Pacific Power by an unfair competitive disadvantage.
