NOTICE RESCHEDULING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING (Now set for October 16, 2019, at 9:30 a.m.)

RE: Wash. Utils. & Transp. Comm'n v. Peninsula Sanitation Service, Inc. Docket TG-190476

TO ALL PARTIES:

On July 17, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Complaint for Penalties and Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding; Setting Time for Oral Statements on August 20, 2019 at 9:30 a.m. (Complaint) against Peninsula Sanitation Service, Inc. (Peninsula or Company) for alleged violations of Title 81 RCW and Chapter 480-07 WAC.

On August 2, 2019, Commission staff (Staff) contacted the presiding administrative law judge and, indicating Peninsula's agreement, requested that the brief adjudicative proceeding be rescheduled for October 16, 2019, at 9:30 a.m. Staff explained that the former Commission compliance investigator who investigated Peninsula, giving rise to the alleged violations, was unavailable to testify at the brief adjudicative proceeding on August 20, 2019, but would be available to testify on the date proposed by the parties, October 16, 2019.

The Commission finds good cause to reschedule the brief adjudicative proceeding to October 16, 2019, at 9:30 a.m.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the brief adjudicative proceeding in Docket TG-190476 is rescheduled to Wednesday, October 16, 2019, beginning at 9:30 a.m., in the Commission's hearing room, Room 110, 621 Woodland Square Loop S.E., Lacey, Washington.
