## RE: In re Investigation of Safe To Go Movers For Compliance with WAC 480-15-555, WAC 480-15-560, and WAC 480-15-570 Docket TV-190515

Dear ALJ Chartoff:

Between April and June 2019, staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) conducted a compliance review of Safe To Go Movers (STG) and documented numerous violations of WAC 480-15-555, -560, and -570. The violations disclosed during the review resulted in a proposed "unsatisfactory" safety rating for STG.

On July 1, 2019, the Commission issued a combined Notice of Intent to Cancel and Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding (Notice) informing STG that the Commission would cancel the Company's household goods carrier permit effective August 13, 2019, unless the Company obtained the Commission's approval of a safety management plan prior to that date. The Notice required STG to file any proposed safety management plan by July 26, 2019.

STG submitted its safety management plan to the Commission as required by the Notice. Staff reviewed the proposed plan and determined it is acceptable. Accordingly, Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the brief adjudicative proceeding set to occur on August 1, 2019, and enter an order upgrading the Company's safety rating to "conditional." STG has no objection to cancelling the BAP.
