**NOTICE CANCELLING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING**

RE: *In the Matter of the Investigation of James Moseley, d/b/a You Got It Movers, for Compliance with WAC 480-15-560 and WAC 480-15-570, Docket TV-190808*

TO ALL PARTIES:

In September 2019, regulatory staff (Staff) of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) conducted a compliance review of James Moseley, d/b/a You Got It Movers, (You Got It Movers or Company) and documented 81 violations of Washington Administrative Code 480-15. Based on these violations, Staff proposed the Company receive a “conditional” safety rating.

On October 2, 2019, the Commission issued a Notice of Intent to Cancel Permit as a Household Goods Carrier (Notice) informing You Got It Movers that the Commission will cancel the Company’s household goods carrier permit effective November 23, 2019, unless the Company obtains Commission approval of a safety management plan prior to that date. The Notice required You Got It Movers to file a proposed safety management plan by November 7, 2019, and set a brief adjudicative proceeding (BAP) for November 14, 2019. The BAP was later rescheduled for November 19, 2019, at the parties’ request.

On November 18, 2019, Staff informed the presiding officer that the Company had submitted to Staff a proposed safety management plan. Staff evaluated the proposed plan and determined it is acceptable. As such, Staff recommends the Commission cancel the brief adjudicative proceeding and enter an order addressing the Company’s safety rating based on the evidence in the record.

Staff also explained that it confirmed that the Company waives its right to a hearing. Based on the parties’ request to cancel the hearing, as well as Staff’s approval of the Company’s safety

management plan, the Commission finds good cause to cancel the brief adjudicative proceeding set for November 19, 2019, at 9 a.m. and to enter an order based on the evidence in the record.

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the brief adjudicative proceeding in docket TV-190691 set for November 19, 2019, at 9 a.m. is canceled.**
