## NOTICE CANCELLING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING

## TO ALL PARTIES:

On April 13, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Intent to Cancel Permit as a Household Goods Carrier; Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding; Setting Time for Oral Statements (Notice of BAP). The Notice of BAP, among other things, scheduled a hearing at Commission headquarters for Wednesday, May 20, 2020, at 9:30 a.m.

On May 15, 2020, Commission staff (Staff) filed its Evaluation of Safety Management Plan and Recommendations (Evaluation), in which it states that Staff has reviewed the Safety Management Plan submitted by the Company and believes it meets Commission requirements. In the Evaluation, Staff requests that the Commission cancel the currently scheduled brief adjudicative proceeding and enter an order based on Staff's recommendations, and Staff states that the Company waives its right to a hearing.

Because the Evaluation shows that Staff and the Company have resolved the disputes raised in the Complaint, the Commission finds good cause to cancel the brief adjudicative proceeding.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the brief adjudicative proceeding set for May 20, 2020, at 9:30 a.m. is canceled.
