Dear Mr. Johnson:

Enclosed please find the proposed, revised tariff pages to be included with Tariff No. 27 of 4176 – Fiorito Enterprises, Inc. & Rabanco Ltd, Certificate G-60, (dba Kent-Meridian Disposal Company; dba Allied Waste Services of Kent; dba Republic Services of Kent).

One proposed change in the tariff reflects the change in the commodity credit for residential customers in the Service Areas defined in Appendix A from a credit of \$0.36 to a credit of \$0.02 per month and for multifamily customers, from a credit of \$0.18 to a debit of \$0.01 per yard. We are asking that this rate become effective on August 1, 2020.

The other proposed change in tariff reflects a rate increase due to a 0.25% increase in Washington State B&O tax (effective April 2020) and an increase in residential yard waste disposal rate to \$65 per ton (effective September 2020). We are asking that this rate become effective on August 1, 2020.

As required by Commission rules, a copy of this transmittal letter will be mailed to the King County Chair impacted by this filing.
