Waste Management of Washington, Inc. ("WM") appreciates this opportunity to respond to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's (the "Commission") April 28, 2022, Notice of Opportunity to File Written Comments ("April 28 Notice") in the above-entitled docket. The April 28 Notice requests stakeholder input on a wide range of topics, and it is not clear what, if any, rulemaking may follow.

Attached as Exhibit A are WM's responses to the specific inquiries contained in the April 28 Notice.

Note that certain inquiries request confidential or proprietary information, are overly burdensome given the time frame for responding, or ask for information older than routinely retained under Commission requirements and WM's records retention policy.
