GRANTING PAYMENT
ARRANGEMENT

BACKGROUND

- 1 On May 6, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$5,700 penalty (Penalty Assessment) against Queen City Business Movers, LLC, d/b/a Queen City Movers (Queen City or Company) for 57 violations of WAC 480-15-570.
- 2 On April 28, 2022, Queen City filed with the Commission a request for mitigation of the penalty, admitting the violations and requesting the Commission issue a decision based on the information provided.
- 3 On June 8, 2022, the Commission entered Order 01, Denying Mitigation (Order 01). Order 01 required Queen City to work with Staff to establish a mutually agreeable payment arrangement by June 20, 2022.
- 4 On June 9, 2022, Staff contacted the Executive Director and Secretary of the Commission explaining that the Company requested to pay the penalty in 23 monthly installments, and that Staff supports the request. The Company and Staff jointly propose the following payment schedule:

5 Staff also proposes that if Queen City fails to pay any installment by the due date, the entire balance, including the suspended penalty, will become due and payable immediately.

DISCUSSION

6 The installment payment schedule Staff and the Company propose is reasonable. Accordingly, the Commission approves the proposal with one modification. Queen City may make additional payments in advance of the payment due dates or pay an increased amount on the due dates, but no additional payment or increased amount will relieve the Company of its obligation to make its timely monthly installment until the full amount of \$5,700 is satisfied.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 7 (1) The \$5,700 penalty is due and payable to the Commission in installments as set out in paragraph 4, above.
- 8 (2) If Queen City Business Movers, LLC, d/b/a Queen City Movers fails to pay any installment by 5 p.m. on the date it is due, the unpaid balance will immediately become due and payable without further order by the Commission.

- 9 The Secretary has been delegated authority to enter this order on behalf of the Commissioners under WAC 480-07-904(1)(h).
